

## **ST. BRIGID'S THIRD WORLD GROUP CHARITY FUND**

### **NARRATIVE REPORT OF HOW THE MONEY WILL BE USED**

This is a brief narrative report of a proposed plan on how the funds received will be used. Taking into consideration the constitutional mandate for the use of the funds, I intend to expend the funds on the following:

**Objective 1. To prevent starvation and malnutrition and to assist in the physical development of children and their concentration and learning (feeding programmes)**

**1.1 Provision of food and non-food items to inmates of Sir Milton Margai Cheshire Home in Bo.**

This charity home housed 30 physically disabled children. The home in recent year is faced with a lot of challenges financially to meet the needs of the children as support from international and govern are not forth coming. With the charity fund, I plan to provide food (rice) and non-food items for the children to augment their daily survival and concentration in learning in school.

**1.2 Provide food items for the vulnerable aged members of the St. Theresa's parish Sumbuya.**

There are presently 70 registered needy community members within the parish community with varied degrees of vulnerability. The support will be done in two forms; the first will involve direct support to St. Vincent De Paul society of St. Pious parish with food items to support their weekly feeding programme at the church compound for the entire community members and the second, on individual basis based on need especially those who visit the parish house.

**Objective 2. To alleviate and prevent suffering and disease and provide dignity for the dying (health and hospice care):**

Many deaths in Sierra Leone could be prevented but due to poverty to meet the cost of good medical care the latter become inevitable. In order to alleviate suffering and provide dignity for the dying, I shall provide some medical and hospice care for some vulnerable members of the parish community.

**Objective 4. To enable people to gain or make a living and support their families (education, books, equipment and training)**

Educational support with the aim of enabling people to gain employment or make a living and support their families had been one of the most critical interventions over the years with the use of the funds received. In the same vein, I wish to provide scholastic materials for vulnerable children; pay tuition fees for vulnerable college students.
